

ORDINANCE NO. 593

AN ORDINANCE BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMAN OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH, MISSISSIPPI, ESTABLISHING A GENERAL TRASH CONTAINER/RECYCLING BIN ORDINANCE WITHIN THE CITY OF LONG BEACH, MISSISSIPPI REQUIRING THAT ALL GARBAGE AND/OR RECYCLABLE MATERIAL CONTAINERS PLACED FOR COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL OR REMOVAL OF ITS CONTENTS SHALL BE PLACED AT THE DESIGNATED COLLECTION AREA NO MORE THAN TWENTY-FOUR (24) HOURS PRIOR TO 8:00A.M. ON THE DAY SCHEDULED FOR COLLECTION, AND ALL SUCH CONTAINERS MUST BE REMOVED FROM THE COLLECTION LOCATION NO LATER THAN TWENTY-FOUR (24) HOURS AFTER 8:00 A.M. OF THE DAY THE GARBAGE AND RECYCLABLE MATERIALS WERE COLLECTED; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Long Beach, Mississippi, having made due investigation therefore, do now find, determine, adjudicate and declare that it is necessary and proper to adopt the following ordinance governing and relating to the placement and collection of garbage and/or recyclable material containers within the city limits of the City of Long Beach, Mississippi; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH, MISSISSIPPI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. All garbage and/or recyclable material containers placed for collection and disposal or removal of its contents shall be placed at the designated collection area no more than twenty-four (24) hours prior to 8:00 a.m. on the day scheduled for collection, and all such containers must be removed from the collection location no later than twenty-four (24) hours after 8:00 a.m. of the day the garbage and recyclable materials were collected unless reasonable cause can be shown by the user of said garbage and/or recyclable material container for exceeding the time provided herein.

Section 2. Failure to remove such containers placed for collection and disposal or removal of its contents from the designated collection area and return of same to an area immediately adjacent to the residence and/or building structure from which the containers were placed shall constitute a misdemeanor and subject the user of same to citation by municipal authorities.

Section 3. Upon a third citation for failure to remove such containers placed for collection and disposal or removal of its contents from the designated collection area and return of same to an area immediately adjacent to the residence/and or building structure for which the

containers were placed, and for each subsequent violation thereafter, the user may be fined in an amount not to exceed \$50.00 per day or occurrence.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days after its adoption, publication and enrollment thereof as provided by law.

The above and foregoing Ordinance No. 593 was introduced in writing by Alderman Lishen who moved its adoption. Alderman Hammons seconded the motion to adopt the Ordinance, and after discussion, no member of the Board of Aldermen having requested the Ordinance to be read by the City Clerk, and the question being put to a roll call vote, the result was as follows:
