

ORDINANCE NO. 478

AN ORDINANCE BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH, MISSISSIPPI, ADOPTING VARIOUS BUILDING AND RELATED CODES AND STANDARDS, AND APPENDIXES REGULATING AND CONTROLLING THE DESIGN, CONSTRUCTION, QUALITY OF MATERIALS, ERECTION, INSTALLATION, ALTERATION, REPAIR, LOCATION, RELOCATION, REPLACEMENT, ADDITION TO, USE OR MAINTENANCE OF BUILDINGS AND STRUCTURES, PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF PERMITS AND COLLECTION OF FEES THEREFORE WHEN USED WITH MONEY; PROVIDING FOR AND RELATING TO INSPECTION ACTIVITIES AND ENFORCEMENT OF BUILDING PROVISIONS AS PROVIDED IN VARIOUS CODES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Long Beach, Mississippi, having made due investigation therefor, do now find, determine, adjudicate and declare that it is necessary, proper, and in the public interest and welfare to adopt in all respects the various standards and revisions relating to electrical, building, fire prevention, gas, housing, mechanical, plumbing, unsafe building abatement, amusement device, swimming pools, sound control and hurricane resistant residential construction; and

WHEREAS, the adoption of these codes, revisions, standards and appendixes is done to facilitate proper inspection activities by the City of Long Beach, Mississippi, relating to construction and to maintenance of buildings within the city limits of the City of Long Beach, Mississippi all in aid and furtherance of the public safety, health and general welfare;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH, MISSISSIPPI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Adoption

The following Standards, Revisions, and Appendixes are hereby and herein adopted as if copied in words and figures in full and ordered, ordained, decreed and declared an ordinance of the City of Long Beach, Mississippi.

SECTION 2. REPEAL OF INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES

Any ordinances or provisions of any code of the City which are in conflict with or contrary to the provisions of this Ordinance, and the Codes and Standards and Appendixes adopted hereby, are, to the extent of such conflict, repealed.

SECTION 3. RESPONSIBLE OFFICIALS

Any duties of officials to whom reference is made within the Codes and Standards and Appendixes adopted hereby are and shall hereafter be deemed to be the duties of the current municipal official with corresponding duties and responsibilities for enforcing the provisions of and carrying out duties assigned under the Code.

SECTION 4. SUBSTITUTION OF NAMES

Wherever the Codes adopted use or refer to the words or terms ~~Board of Adjustments and Appeals~~ and ~~Construction Board of Adjustments and Appeals~~ appear, there is hereby substituted the words ~~Mayor and Board of Alderman of the City of Long Beach~~. There will be no requirement that the members of the Board of Alderman be otherwise qualified to serve in such capacity.

SECTION 5. Severability

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance, or the application thereof, be held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such holding shall not affect the remaining portions of this ordinance.

SECTION 6. Effective Date


In order to provide for the health and safety of the public and this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its adoption, and proper publication and enrollment of same in the municipal records all as and in the manner provided by law.

The above and foregoing Ordinance No. 478 was introduced in writing by Alderman Levens, who moved its adoption. Alderman Rouse seconded the motion to adopt the Ordinance, and after discussion, and the question being put to a roll call vote, the result was as follows:


Alderman Holder	voted Aye
